Councillors and representatives from Grampian Police regularly attend meetings, so issues can be quickly passed on to the appropriate authorities to be remedied. Examples which have been brought up recently by forum members include the winter road conditions and anti-social behaviour in Elgin. We have monthly meetings with the council and contractors about the new Elgin Academy – **see overleaf more details**. We have been involved in consultations regarding the flood scheme, the proposed Western Distributor Road and changes to traffic restrictions.
