The outcomes of this meeting were that all decided the signs should be central to the High Street. Also to look at using the panels in the bus shelters as signs. Should be cheaper, needs costing. Other signs like the finger pointers could be placed at the top of Tolbooth Street and be similar to the black wrought iron and gold 'Street Maps' in Elgin. Fabio suggested Gazette coverage to allow local consultation whilst costing. Jeff Hamilton has agreed to action this point.</li> <li>FiB £1,000 from MTP for Heritage Trail brochure – Sandra will send estimates to Alan Macbeth.</li> <li>Carin explained there was a misunderstanding with Bear Scotland about the four 'Welcome to Forres' signs on entrance to Forres. The theme this year will be wild flowers & heritage with a change in bedding plants towards more sustainable bedding. Been in touch with Col Sturrock of 39 Royal Engineers, who are happy to make sign for planting the market green raised bed to welcome the army.  Naomi: Attended meeting yesterday on proposed Maternity Service Changes. Appalled by proposed changes leading to lack of services. Roddy Burns suggested she take issue up with Cllr Bell.
