6. Moray Towns Partnership (MTP)	There have been no MTP meetings. Forres in Bloom (FiB) working on greenhouse planning, advice required from TMC Planning Department - £5,000 still to be spent. Distribution of Transport Directory A5 booklets to all households within Moray - request from Fabio Villani, tsiMoray for £500 to help with distribution costs – members present voted with no objections - agreed to the donation of MTP money for this project. Secretary to contact Alan Macbeth, (TMC) to see if this request is possible.	ТС

8. Forres Area Community Trust (FACT)	Debbie Herron has been busy working on FACT's Growth Plan. Frances Powell dealing with the Learning Centre and exploring the possibility of FACT taking on the Learning Centre building. Frances Powell and Samantha Fraser volunteered to help out at Culture Day and the Findhorn Bay Arts Festival, all 3 staff are preparing for the Spirit of Community event on 2 <sup>nd</sup> October 2014. The Town Centre Working Group held a meeting last week – two items came up – how to contribute towards the Christmas lights which are to be switched on on 29 <sup>th</sup> November 2014 and looking at how to contribute towards promotion and publicity. There are 3 new shops on the High Street, which is vibrant. Gary Simpson - youth bands would appreciate the opportunity to contribute and help raise their profile on the town centre lights switch	



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9. Community Engagement	on night. Debbie and Frances are juggling their workloads and the first Tourism Group meeting will happen on 7 <sup>th</sup> October 2014 where Debbie will explain what FACT do. Vice Chair received communications from Eleanor Hayward who would be interested in starting a Scarecrow Festival – would FACT be interested in this? – FACT busy this year but may look at this in the future. Development Trust for Scotland conference was attended in August – good to hear about other development trusts. Spirit of Community event, 2 <sup>nd</sup> October 2014 in the Town Hall Forres from 6.30 – 9.30 pm - this is a community led approach by those persons living within the Forres Academy catchment area. Gary Simpson will set up a PA system. There will be a video backdrop to be shown at the beginning of the evening with the use of the Film Forres screen. Noted that there is a lack of young people attending on the night – will have to connect with younger people at a later date. Technique to be used by facilitators on the night is S – strengths,	
	O – opportunities, A – aspirations and R – results. Town Hall will be open from 5.30 pm onwards.

Date of	Debbie Herron – Highlands and Islands Executive put in an application to Skills Development Scotland for World Host Training – they have been successful in match funding of up to 50% available for those who have face to face interaction with members of the public – one day training could result in world host training accreditation – aim is to lift quality of service in the area. Price not yet finalised but in the region of £80 - £90 but with 50% funding brings cost down to around £40. Training opportunities to come soon – aiming for Forres to become a world host destination.
