Community Engagement Group	Update re Community Engagement group being temporarily disbanded. Concerns were raise that the decision was taken at a Full Council meeting on 7 <sup>th</sup> July and there had been no consultation. A meeting is to be held later in the year to discuss the closure of MVSO and the impact of this possible resulting in there being no forum for voluntary sector engagement. Development Trust Association	Described as an umbrella organisation for Community Trusts Fabio fed back re his attendance at National Conference in Aviemore. Consideration to be given to inviting a speaker to the FAF meeting in October. There was a brief discussion about the closure of Mackenzie and Cruickshank. Round the Table	Discussions about the retirement of a Forres councillor. Elections need to take place within six weeks of a resignation being submitted. Irene Ogilvie gave an update on the petition to 'save Leanchoil Hospital'.
