3	Matters Arising	
	Minute 06 August 2009	
	• Young Carers. Gill is now working with Quarriers Advisory Group and is trying very hard to ensure that young people contact the organisation to inform them of what support they require. Gill has attended events with Quarriers but didn't recognise any of the	

	 carers – so what has happened to all those other young people who were carers and attended events with Moray Carers Project? Has there been a change in criteria? Susan Leonard, Manager for Quarriers in Moray, has offered to come along to a Forum meeting to explain how the service is being developed in Moray. The meeting agreed that this would be useful and it was suggested that the meeting after the AGM would be most suitable. However, it was agreed that the issue of young carers would continue to be monitored by the Forum. Voluntary Sector Partnership Moray. The launch of this new body was due to be held on 01 April 2010. This, however, has been put on hold indefinitely as a result of the requirement of Scottish Government for a single interface organisation to be created. This will instigate a merger between MVSO and VCM.

5	BCE Youth Involvement Sub-Group	
	Anita proposed that this project be submitted as a pilot project as part of the Better Community Engagement Demonstration Project. This was agreed and Fiona was asked to arrange a meeting of the group.	Fiona

	Anita explained the background to these documents. She and Sylvia had met with Fiona to complete the Needs Assessment and the resulting Support Agreement had been drawn up.

7	Allotment Groups	
	• Fochabers Allotment Group. Anita Gouldsbrough gave a brief report on the progress of the Steering Group. The AGM is planned for 11 March. 25 people have expressed an interest and the group are in the process of issuing membership forms. They	
	have worked very hard on the constitution and it now meets the requirements of the Moray Council Legal Services Department. However, as the Council have no suitable land available in Fochabers, the group have been in consultation with private landlords over possible areas of land for allotments.	
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	 due to adverse weather conditions – but there is a meeting planned for next Monday. Main items for discussion are – i) the budget consultation which took place in November last year; ii) consideration of the allocation of funds to Forums and Community Councils; iii) a presentation on the CSU and the work of the unit to date. 10	Community Issues	
	• Sylvia informed the meeting that Fochabers Heritage was leading a project on regenerating the square in Fochabers. Planned improvements included building seats round the trees.	
	• Kay mentioned that, as most who travel the A96 corridor know, the Fochabers by-pass has now started and is causing mayhem. However, it was agreed that we will all have to put up with some pain for long-term gain!	
	• Debi explained that the youth worker complement for the Milne's area currently was a Senior Youth Worker, a Youth Worker and 2 Youth Work Assistants (all very part-time). However, due to cut backs, some of the posts are being axed at the end of March. There is also to be a reconfiguration of the Youth Team – but as yet the outcome of this is not known. The Drop In are pushing forward with the re-decoration of the youth room in Lhanbryde Community Centre and it is looking good so far, although there is still much to do. Kerry and Daniel are currently working in the high school on youth achievement awards. Debi thought that this way of working, both through the school and with the young people in the Drop In was really starting to reap benefits. She sees a huge difference in the young people they have had contact with over the past year.	
	• Anita M informed the meeting that Lhanbryde CC now has a new Centre Development Worker, who is very proactive and keen to see and support new activities etc in the building.	
	• Gill informed members that she had been made aware that there were thieves about who were targeting tools – so be warned and be careful with those pieces of equipment left lying about! She also commented that her road was not cleared or gritted during the recent major snows. Given that most of the residents of her street are older people, they were forcibly house-bound as a result and for as long as the snow lasted.	
	• Anita G informed the members that the car park at Speymouth Hall had huge potholes which were going to cause some serious damage if they are not repaired soon. Also that the hall was facing a large bill for the replacement of the floor in the main hall which was damaged by water. So they are fundraising by producing a cook book! Anita is asking groups and individuals to donate recipes for inclusion and hoped to have it ready for the Mosstodloch Fair Day on the 15 th August. The post office in	

	Mosstodloch has now closed – a great inconvenience to those living in Mosstodloch, particularly the elderly.
