5	Community Transport Seminar	
	Anita reported that this initiative had started with the difficulties expressed	

by older people in the Milne's area in attending hospital/ doctor's appointments, but had now been widened out following the comments made at the Enabling Health and Wellbeing seminar held in the Town Hall in April. The Moray Forum is now promoting the seminar and a small Steering Group is to be established to plan and deliver it. They have received funding from the Change Fund - £500.00 towards the cost, however, all Forums are to be asked to contribute by arranging and paying for transport for the older people from their area to the seminar. It is hoped to hold it in September, but there is a great deal of work to be done to bring it all together. Lhanbryde Community Centre has been proposed as a venue but this has yet to be agreed.

It was agreed that Milne's Neighbourhood Forum should support this venture in what ever way they can. Proposed Paul, seconded Gill.

6 Speymouth Action Group
