Two events took place, in Keith and Elgin and involved 75 young drivers and passengers. Operation Taurus - Drink Drive - 20 Taurus events have taken place to date within communities across Moray. During 31 hours of road checks, 584 drivers were stopped and checked and 197 of those drivers were breathalysed. No positive breath tests recorded.	100 %
