1 Welcome and Introductions

2 Group overview and remit

There were several names discussed and it was also noted that the Chamber of Commerce and/or the Federation of Small Business may be a good contact for business representations.

The Moray Employability Strategy has been completed and will be presented to the CPP for approval on the 22nd August. There is an Employability focus group meeting on the 10th September to discuss the Strategy. There is also a meeting on the 6th September with the Schools/Skills Development Scotland/employers and Guidance staff to discuss forging close links between business and education.

It was agreed that the outputs from these meeting and the Employability Strategy should inform the priorities of the STG. In connection with this it was agreed that a representative from Education should be invited to a meeting of the group to ensure that there is communication between the 2.
