Partner Response:

On the suggestion that the Council should stop economic development because HIE does it the response is category 3: We can't take this forward as Economic Development involves a wide range of activities not undertaken by HIE, the community needs to provide and maintain the infrastructure to support and grow the local economy (employment) and local authorities are expected to help to drive economic growth largely because they are well placed to do so.

On the suggestion of enabling participation, the response is category 2: The Moray Economic Partnership brings the public and private sectors together to facilitate employment and to attract and retain, skilled employment which is generally better paid.

On the suggestion that improved broadband and mobile phone networks should be a priority Lead by HIE the response is category 2- this is a priority, in March 2017, 91% of premises have access to superfast broadband. The Scottish Government has committed to achieving 100% by 2021. Private sector Mobile Phone network providers are upgrading networks and improving coverage to enable 4G by the end of 2017.

On the suggestions of not spending money on studies and the Council's economic development section, the response is that studies are required to determine the feasibility of investment.

On the suggestion of that the Council's economic development section is not fit for purpose and to stop using it, we advise that economic development is not confined to the work of one

section in the Council, it cuts across several services. This misunderstanding likely lies in that the primary function of the Council's "economic development section" is to help Council services attract external funding and to provide business support, which includes Business Gateway support for small and medium sized enterprises. HIE's focus is providing support for large enterprises over 50 employees in key sectors of the economy as well as help to stimulate the economies of the more fragile rural communities.

On the suggestion of start supporting rural communities, the response is category 2: For example the National Park Authority, the Moray Council and Highlands and Islands partnership are facilitating the Tomintoul and Glenlivet Regeneration Plan, including the Landscape Partnership.
