<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• On the suggestion of having an economic development staff officer allocated to Dufftown, the response is category 3: The Moray Council Community Support Unit has helped the local community to develop a community action plan. An officer dedicated to Dufftown would require the local community to identify new funds for this purpose or for public agencies such as Moray Council or HIE to redirect funds from other activities.
