	Capital grant – looking for £3 million plus to refurbish the Town Hall (TH), waiting to see how funding applied for goes so we have a picture going forward over the next couple of years.  Jim Farquharson is the new Chair with Vice Chair not decided as yet.  Will be looking for new Director's and looking at the recruitment process.	
7. Town Centre Improvement Plans	Michelle has attended meetings with Kirsty Conti, MC, meeting on 16 <sup>th</sup> May cancelled as MC secured money for a Development Person for a year. This person will coordinate ideas of what people in Forres want to do for the next 5 years, FACT would like to be involved by pulling together information and working closely with MC and other organisations. This is to be community led, Michelle attended the Forres Community Council (FCC) meeting, good dynamic feel and the FCC is looking to make a difference, Michelle followed up with FCC Chair.  Development Post to be advertised over summertime and possibly in post for September.  Martin is to share group information with Michelle and	
8. Spirit of Community 2022	Kirsty.  Draft document is with Angus, MC, he is aiming to have a draft for the second to last week in June. Community Support Unit (CSU) were to be the lead to review each year, discussed and provisionally agreed FACT will review annually in conjunction with the CSU – Michelle to check with FACT Board and then liaise with Gordon and Dawn at MC. Angus to email draft document to Michelle who will co-ordinate the replies, the draft document to be emailed out to the wider steering groups also to include FCC. Angus to take more photos of the area for the draft.  Directory launch will take place at the same time – possibly launch in August, date tbc.	MR MG MG
9. Mannachie Park	Scope of service will go out over the summer holidays and then to a public vote when the schools are back, Martin to check with Laura and confirm with Secretary.  Unsuccessful application to Berry Burn Fund, could apply again on 18 <sup>th</sup> September but aiming to be in by 11 <sup>th</sup> September in order to get the application checked.	MR
10. Developer Contributions to Forres ASG	Martin – criteria was strict and application form had to be changed to suit the development obligation requirements – various groups invited to attend steering group, not many engaged. The application devised by the steering group was not acceptable and had to be changed, the criteria was very strict and there were queries, applications to the

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	value of £2.5k received.  Developer obligations are to revert back to the usual process which is to seek permission from the Elected Members in the area to give money to the groups that applied – Michelle to feedback on the form so Martin can learn from the feedback.  Participatory Budgeting (PB) – 2 pots of money: £20k – youth activities – 13 applications received £40k – youth spaces – 3 applications received Both closed now and will go to a vote in school before the end of June and can do PB, a well subscribed process. This has been a lot of work – looks like money will be spent.	
11. Money for Moray	Just Transition PB – first funding roadshow launch on 26 <sup>th</sup> June in Elgin and other meetings all over Moray. Forres meeting is on 12 <sup>th</sup> July in the Community Centre from 3pm to 8pm. Funding is mainly for carbon reduction £500k in the pot with awards of up to £50k. The money is split with £225k open to any group to apply for and the further £225k is only open to groups who do not have paid staff. £50k is to be used for a Youth Participatory Budget which Fiona Herd will run.	
12. Moray Towns Partnership	In abeyance	
13. Moray Forum	Martin informed all the Moray Forum has adopted a new constitution and meet 21st June. Martin has drafted a constitution for all the individual forums in order to bring them in line with each other i.e. all AGM's at the same time and improve communication. Draft is to be finalised and presented on 21st June and then discussion how it feeds up to the Community Engagement Group.  Forums – none in Elgin and look at how to bring in more organisations to make it more equitable. Also highlight the differences between Community Councils and Area Forums, there is the potential for conflict over who does what and why. Moving forward looking to strengthen links to the Community Planning Partnership. Area Forums have huge value reinvigorating on a Moray wide scale. MC withdrew financial support and as a community organisation could look to identify smaller funds and draw them down, could look at small funders i.e. Co-op and Awards for All. Could also be something the Moray Forum could look at on a wider level, could look at community empowerment by working together.

Suggestion of showing the Councillors the Spirit of Community Report and ask if there is anything in there that the money could fund. Chair to write to ask them to come along.	SM
14. Transport Forum	Angela and David attended on 6 <sup>th</sup> June at Elgin Town all, 9 in attendance although 60 on the email distribution list. Discussed the top 3 priorities and 3 short term goals – no Stagecoach representation. Joint Community Council representative attended. New M.Connect discussed numbers have increased. The express service discussed, it has limited stops going from Inverness to Aberdeen. Paper based bus timetables discussed, it is MC responsibility to put into shelters but there are none at present, most bus shelters have no paper timetables but it was mentioned that could access timetables on an app on phones for those with the technology. The newly formed Transport Forum is progressing a draft action plan but still requires input from more members. Martin to forward on to me the 3 key priorities for emailing round FAF members. Next meeting is on 11 <sup>th</sup> /12 <sup>th</sup> July, Martin to confirm.	MR MR
