David passed on some historical information about the origins of bridge – it appears that the current bridge is the 3 rd bridge as previous bridges got washed away! The ownership is still under discussion although it looks as if it may be the Council – there is just one small bit of the jigsaw to find to make the case watertight. Lossie Development Trust has been set up and they would be interested in taking on ownership of the bridge.
