Anita reported that it would be worth looking into Development Grants from Cycling Scotland that had just become available to develop cycle routes. 9	Around the table – issues/concerns in your area		
3	 9.1 Gill expressed her concern about the development of the Tennant Arms and is pleased that the Forum had put in a submission regarding the potential traffic problems. Anne echoed her concerns about the traffic. 9.2 Ian explained that he had successfully applied to Scottish Government for £65,000 to be used to support rural development. This was matched funded by Economic Development and so a sum of £120,000 		
	would be available to be allocated in a Participatory Budgeting exercise to support economic development (in its widest sense) in the rural areas of Moray. Anita stressed that this is very much a community led project and she is hoping that local people will get involved not only on the Steering Group but also in thinking about possible projects in their area.
